

THREE MYTHS ABOUT THE CRUSADES AND WHY THEY MATTER JANUARY 10-11, 2020

Explore the history and impact of the crusades through three common myths: the crusaders were motivated by land, power, and wealth rather than by religion; the crusades were wars of conversion; the crusades initiated conflict between the west and the Muslim world that continue uninterrupted to the present. Each one of these myths has shaped the way people today think about the crusades and, what's more important, how they think about the church. Recognizing that and learning the truth can help us speak more effectively to others about our hope in Christ.



Dr. Paul Robinson is professor of Historical Theology at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis. Robinson's areas of interest and expertise include the late Medieval church, Martin Luther, and the history of preaching. He received his Master of Divinity and Master of Sacred Technology from Concordia Seminary (1989, 1994). He also holds a bachelor's degree from Concordia University, Chicago in River Forest, Ill. (1985), and a Ph.D. from the University of Chicago (2001). Robinson is editor of The Annotated Luther Volume 3: Church and Sacraments, to which he also contributed the selection "On the Councils and the Church" (Augsburg). He is author of the biography Martin Luther: A Life Reformed (Pearson Longman). In addition to writing essays and articles for other publications and various journals, Robinson has presented at conferences around the country and internationally. He and his wife, Jane, have three children.
